The question of processing of NonDestructive evaluation (NDE) signals is of prime importance, it allows to assess material integrity and quantify detected flaws with reliability. The scope of this *Sixth International Workshop* will be particularly focused on the cross-fertilization of the fields of NDE and signal processing with participation of international specialists from both fields. Additionally, the Workshop will be an opportunity to perform a reflection on recent developments and also analyze new emerging techniques which are seen promising. We recall that the previous Workshops were held (now every four year) respectively in 1987, 1993, 1997, 2001, and 2005, all in Quebec City. For 2009, the *Sixth Edition* of the *International Workshop* had the unique opportunity to be part of the "2009 National Conference: NDT in Canada" which will include tutorial and industrial sessions as well as an exhibition.

Prospective authors are invited to submit their abstract before the deadline (see below). The Committee will then select papers for presentation, and organize the final program. Papers will be presented in lecture sessions and published in a proceedings book. English is the official language of the Workshop (for both written papers and oral presentation). The Workshop will be held at "Spencer Ivey Leadership Center" (London, Ontario, Canada), an historically significant Georgian manor on 30 beautifully landscaped acres of parkland. Lodging and meals will be available on site. London, Ontario is known as the "Forest City", while it is large enough to have everything needed - in dining, culture, entertainment, shopping, sports - but with the added plus of a friendly ambience that is reminiscent of smaller communities.
